Things to Bring to Camp!

Money for Lunch and dinner on Sunday, lunch on Monday, free time dinner on Tuesday, lunch and dinner on the way home!

Linens, towels, pillows, blankets

Water Bottle

Closed toe, closed heel shoes (for outdoor activities and mission sites)

Bible, notepad, and pen

Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc)

Sun protection

Spending money for snacks, Fuge store, and missions offering (5 meals on the road)

DRESS CODE

Q: What is the dress code for M-Fuge?

A: Please ask your students not to pack anything that:

- Advertises alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs
- Explicitly or implicitly promotes racism, sexism, or hatred of any group or person
- Explicitly or implicitly refers to sexual actions or situations
- Has spaghetti straps, except for sleepwear
- Is excessively short or tight fitting

While at camp, we ask that students and adults:

- Wear modest, one-piece bathing suits or two piece suits covered with a colored T-shirt.
- Wear modest shorts, dresses, slacks, and jeans for worship. Long pants or knee-length skirts are required for on-stage performances.
- Don't dress in a way that calls attention to their underwear (sagging your pants, rolling down your waistbands, etc)
- A dark t-shirt if you plan on taking any messy games or water games track
- While at Ministry Sites, we ask that students and adults:
- Wear closed-toe and closed-heel shoes and no sleeveless shirts on Ministry Site
- Do not even bring soffe shorts or any other cheerleading shorts!

I CAN PROMISE YOU THAT IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW THE DRESS CODE, YOU WILL BE EMBARRASSED WHEN ASKED TO GO BACK AND CHANGE CLOTHES! ASK AROUND!
